### Conflict Minerals Statement

Section 1502 of the “Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Customer Protection Act” identifies “Conflict Minerals” as potentially financing armed conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and the surrounding region. Companies publically traded in the USA must determine if any of their products contain tin, tantalum, tungsten or gold and identify the source of these substances. They must also submit a conflict minerals declaration annually to the SEC.

Some of our products contain small amounts of tin and/or gold. The supply chain associated with “Conflict Minerals” is complex and there are multiple supply chain layers that separate us from the smelters and mines from which these are sourced.

Whilst NSF Controls is not subject to the SEC Conflict Minerals rule, we fully understand the importance of this issue and continue to work with our suppliers to ensure that we are a Conflict Free supplier.
